

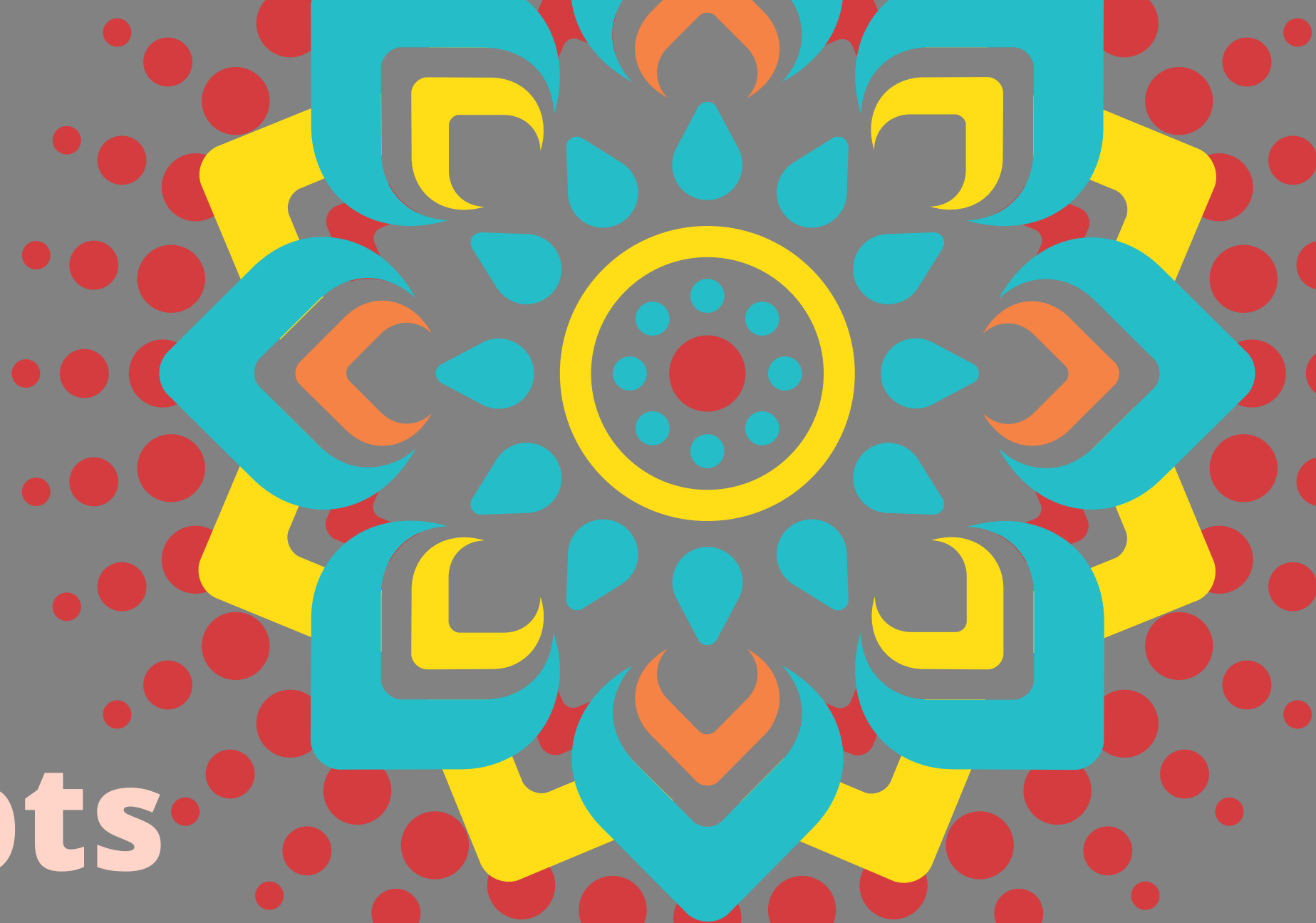
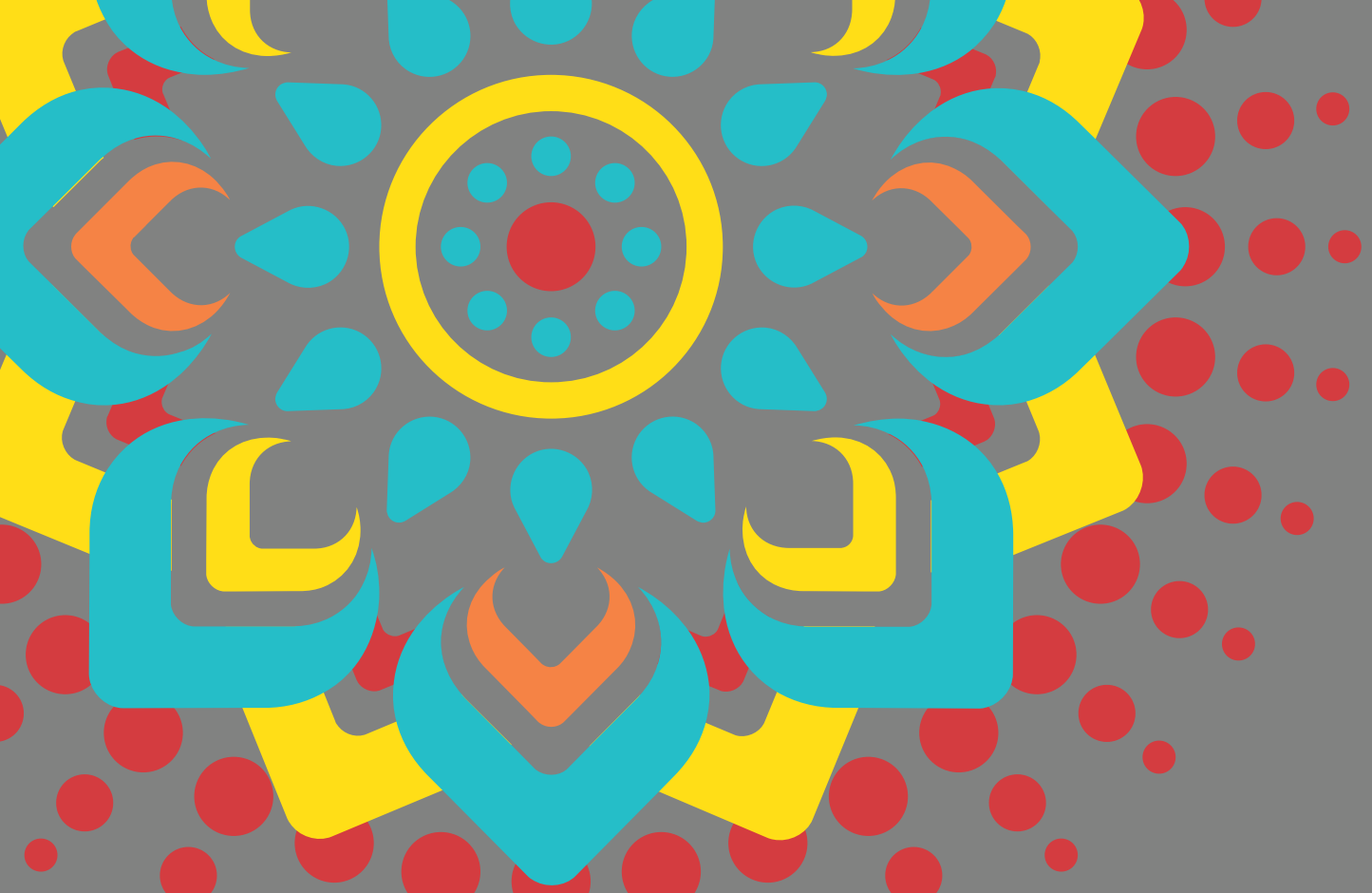

JUDGING CRITERIA: Evaluations conducted by judges are final. Judging is based on the following criteria:



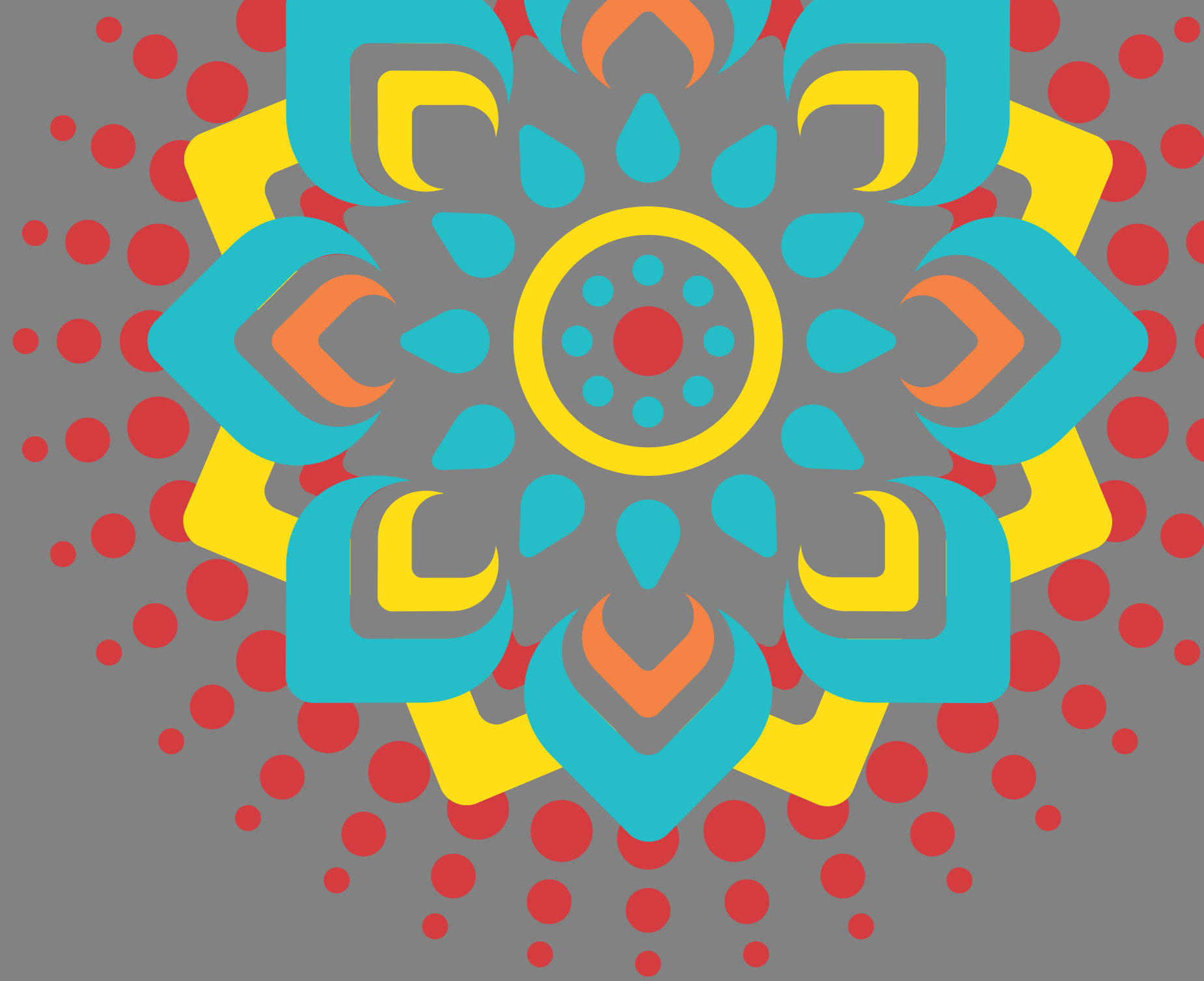
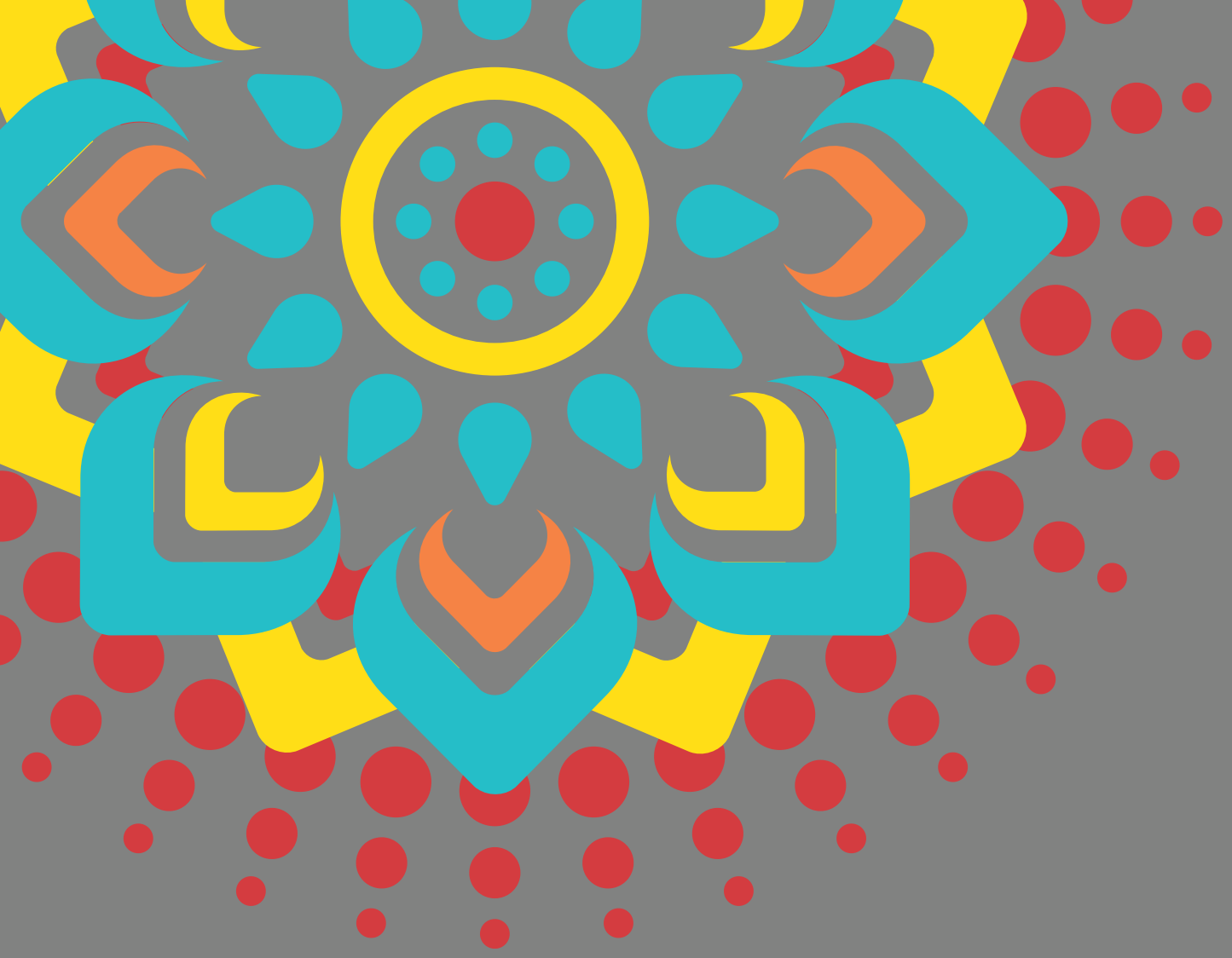
- Expression of the theme

- Sentence fluency: how words and phrases flow
- Conventions: mechanical correctness
- Presentation: overall appearance
